

Hello and thanks for printing these **Squiggle Kids** card templates!

These card templates are designed to celebrate dads and other special friends at the time of Father's Day.

And they're designed to celebrate a child's early marks, including scribble.

These templates aim to help kids get started and have a go drawing. That's why we've included some of the structure for the card.

We recommend sharing the activity with your child and using the prompts to get started. This could include:

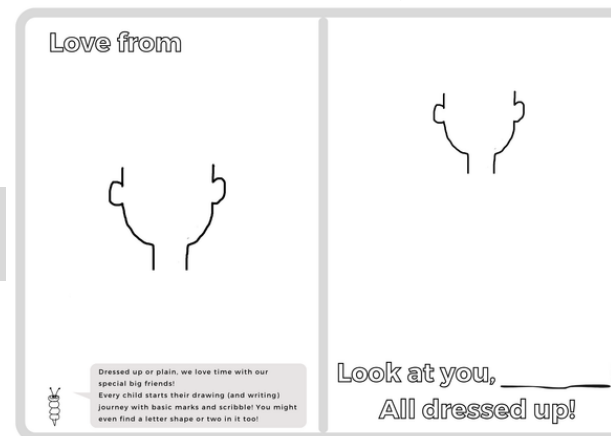
- asking open ended questions about the drawings
- asking "what else could be on dad's/friend's face?"
- singing while tracing a finger over your child's drawings or using your finger to indicate where your child could add a mark.

Choose the special friend card, which has room for the friend's name to be added (pages 5 and 6). Or choose the card for Dad (pages 3 and 4).

Print these card templates on A4 paper, landscape orientation and double sided. Or print single sided and attach each side to a piece of cardboard for a thicker card.

Add hair and clothes!
Then ask: "What else is on Dad/friend's face?"

Add child's face and hair.



Add name of special friend

Ask your child what they love to do with Dad/friend. Try suggesting simple things to start - a ball with grass, swimming together (start with water).

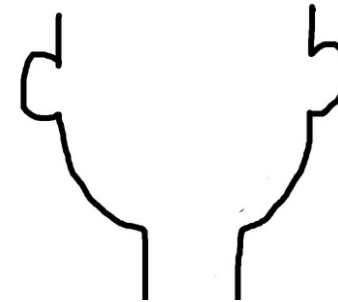
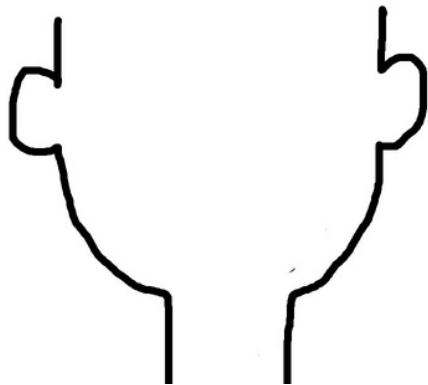
